

Corby Technical School: Home learning guidance

Staff across the School and wider Trust have been working hard to prepare home learning resources for all of our students.

Most resources will be available on 'Microsoft Teams' to enable work to be set and accessed remotely. Students in school today were shown how to use this and for students at home there will be instructions given on our website.
